

80% of the seats are filled through Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) for D. Pharm conducted by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai. For F.Y. B. Pharm & Direct S.Y. B. Pharm conducted by State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra.

20% of the seats are filled as Institute Level Quota by the college according to merit & as per guidelines of the. Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai. For F.Y. B. Pharm & Direct S.Y. B. Pharm conducted by State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra.

### **Eligibility**

### First Year Diploma In Pharmacy (D. Pharm.)

Passed 10+ 2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics/Biology Subject. Note: Outside Maharashtra (OMS) Candidate shall be eligible for institution Quota Only.

### First Year Bachelor Of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.)

Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as Compulsory Subjects along with mathematics or Biology and has obtained at least 45% Marks (at least 40% marks in case of candidates of backward class, Economically Weaker section and person with disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) The candidate should obtain non-zero positive score in NEET or the candidate should appeared in all the subjects in MH-CET and obtain non zero score in MH-CET.



### Analytical Method of Apremilast: A Review

A selective method for separation and determination of potential related impurities (starting materials and b products of synthesis, and degradants) of apremitast drug substance has been developed and validated. The separation was accomplished on a Cosmosil C-18 (250 mm × 4.6 mm, 5 μm) column connected to a photodiodi array (PDA) detector using optimized mixture of 0.05% trifluoroscetic acid, methanol and acetonitrile under gradient elation. Two major degradant impurities found in force degradation study of apremiliest drug substance.

Both degradants were characterized preliminarily by HPLC-MS studies and synthesized in laboratory. Structure was evidenced by NMR spectroscopy, mass spectrometry and HPLC method was developed for quantification of the synthesized impurities along with starting materials. 
