According to "Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act", 1999 "Ragging" means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes-

1. Testing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on, Or causing hurt to, such student; or
2. Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly, do.
3. The Anti- ragging committee to create awareness against and to prevent any ill incidents taking place in the campus as per F.No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009

According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 "Ragging" means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes-

1. Testing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to. Such student or
2. Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly, do.
3. The Anti-ragging committee to create awareness against and to prevent any ill incidents taking place in the campus as per Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948).
4. Depending upon the nature of the offence as established by the Anti- ragging committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those find guilty given as per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
